POLICY NAME	Policy on Moonlighting
DESCRIPTION	<p>“Moonlighting” is the term applied to post-graduate trainees who work for income outside of their training program. The following conditions must apply:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I. Residents who are in the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons specialty training programs must be within their 4th or 5th year of training. II. Residents of the College of Family Physicians of Canada must be in their last 6 months of training. III. LMCC or USMLE Step III must be successfully completed. IV. There must be a letter from the Program Director indicating that the resident is in good standing and that moonlighting will not interfere with their training program. V. Residents must provide Certificates of Standing and apply for licensure on Temporary and Limited Register in the usual process. VI. Residents who are moonlighting will be supervised at Level 4 or Level 5. VII. A letter of support from a local physician of the same specialty must accompany the application
